

Sedum Tile™ Care

The Sedum Tile™ is a mixture of hardy green roof plants in a convenient form. One of the benefits of this product is its ease of installation and care.

Upon receipt of your new Sedum Tiles™:

- Protect them from extremes of weather.
 - If hot, move them to a shady location.
 - If harsh winter winds exist, set them out of the wind, and protect them from frost.
- Store them outside before planting, however they can be kept in warehouse surroundings for a day or two, as long as they are kept cool.
- Do not leave plants in hot closed storage areas.
- Two day's storage in the pallet shipper trays is acceptable while waiting for planting.
 - If more than two days before planting, unpack the plants and expose them to air and light.
 - Once exposed to air and sunlight, water thoroughly once every three days until planting.

Preparation for installation:

- Water the soil medium before planting.
 - This settles the soil, helps to establish desirable capillary actions, and assures a good supply of moisture in the soil for rooting.
- Provide the Sedum Tiles™ with a level soil to be planted on.
 - A wide aluminum landscape rake can be used to create a very flat planting surface.
- When planting place the tiles close to one another, and avoid leaving air gaps in between or beneath them.
- Water thoroughly after planting.
- Overhead irrigation is recommended twice weekly until the roots become well established in the new soil.
 - This usually takes three or four weeks.
 - Plantings made during very cool fall weather may need only one initial irrigation.
